Things you should do, bring or know about each Merit Badge Class

Citizenship in the World: watch email the week before POW WOW for more information Citizenship in the Nation: read as much of the following as you can – Declaration of Independence, Constitution (at least the Preamble), Bill of Rights, and Amendments. Also, watch national news five nights in a row, or bring the front page of five days of a major newspaper. Citizenship in the Community: Bring copies of photos of Los Alamos and Los Alamos souvenirs. Coin Collecting: bring the Merit Badge book and read the requirements before class. Nuclear Science: Must be 14. Will meet an additional time for a field trip to the TRIDENT laser laboratory.

Wood Carving: bring a small, one- or two-bladed pocket knife and a whetstone, if you have them.

Programming: bring an iPad or tablet computer, if you have one (be sure your name and phone number are on it).

Game Design: print and bring a copy of the workbook from the website - <u>http://usscouts.org/mb/worksheets/Game-Design.pdf</u>

Public Speaking: Scout should prepare a three- to five-minute introduction of himself. All others: no special instructions. Keep this section.
