Things you need to do before attending the class.

Trail to First Class: None	Swimming: Please meet at the Aquatic Center (not the White Rock LDS Church) at 12:15 AND pay admission fee. Bring swimsuit/towel.
Geocaching: None	Environmental Science: None
First Aid: None	Citizenship in the World: 3 and 7 can be done as prerequisites (pick/research world event, foreign country, and research certain web sites).
Personal Management: Know how much money you make in a week and month.	Citizenship in the Nation: Watch the national news for 5 days before the Pow-wow, or bring a weeks worth of copies of a statewide newspaper to the pow-wow.
Citizenship in the Community: Bring copies of photos from around Los Alamos or your community.	Genealogy: None
Nuclear Science: Class will meet one additional time for a field trip to the LANSCE facility.	Coin Collecting: Bring your love of money (coins) and your coin collection if you have one.
Communications: Think about topics you could talk or give a speech about for 5 minutes.	Digital Technology: None
